Mr Steven Lim Group CEO, Owner & Founder National Achiever's Award Winner RSTN Consulting Pte Ltd

In 1997, Steven Lim helped his company win an international bid for an automation process for the entire Land Registry system of Indonesia. This project was funded by World Bank and it is one of the largest IT Project ever in the history of Indonesia worth a total of US\$80 million (or S\$137 million). In the same year, Steven was nominated by the World Bank as well as the then Price Waterhouse and won the Singapore's National Achievers Award. This is one of the most prestigious award given to the Top Salesperson within South-East Asia and it is the first time in history that such an award is bestowed upon someone from the IT industry. Steven still remains a record-holder till-date. In the year 2000, Steven once again did his magic by helping his own company win yet another S\$18 million IT contract with AIA Malaysia. For the last few consecutive years, from 2001 till date, Steven Lim has continued his company's "expansion" into the Asia-Pacific region, securing a blanketorder from AIG and AIA. Steven has since, earned himself an unofficial nickname of "Genghis Khan", the Great Mongolia Conqueror. He has been the overall Project Director/Manager for several large-scale, country-wide deployment and implementation for Imaging, Document Management, Content Management and Workflow projects in Singapore, Malaysia, Indonesia, Taiwan, Thailand, Philippines, Hong Kong, and India. He is also a very much sought after keynote speaker within the industry. For the last 25 years, Steven has helped more than 180 companies around the Asia-Pacific Region in implementing and deploying Enterprise-wide Imaging and Workflow technologies.

He was also the Chairman of Singapore's ruling political party (PAP) Youth-Wing for the Serangoon Constituency and is a very active party activist and respected leader well noted for his contributions to Singapore.

In 1993, Steven obtained his Bachelor of Business degree from the Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology (RMIT), and in 2008, obtained his Masters degree of Science from NTU, graduating with the highest GPA score of 4.8 out of 5 for his entire cohort.

From 2013 to 2015, Steven was the Vice Chairman of the Singapore Enterprise Chapter of the Singapore IT Federation (now renamed as SGTech).

In 2021, Steven created and donated SGD1 million to both NTU and SMU

for Scholarships and Bursaries, catering to their final year graduating students. In 2022, he also created his own student-awards at SUSS. He has been appointed by SUSS as a Fellow and is the current Chairman of the RSTN-SUSS Young Executive Development Programme Committee. In June 2022, Steven was invited to join the CASE-Trust Advisory Council member. He is also the Chief Cultural and Trade representative from Shandong Qufu. Steven has several interesting and unique hobbies. To mention one of a few, Steven is a certified and qualified Close-Up Magician. He is the only Asian Chinese Magician to ever compete in the World 2000 Close-Up Magic Competition held in New York (Buffalo) and emerge in Fourth-Placing, a record set within the Asian Magic Fraternity. In 2003, Steven was hand-picked to receive special coaching from the Master-Magicians of Las Vegas (Jeff McBride and Eugene Burger) and is one of the few Asian-Magicians to ever perform live at the Las Vegas Magical Arts Centre. Steven also holds a Black belt 3rd Dan in Tae Kwon Do and is also a seasoned Chinese WuShu practitioner and is the Chairman of Xuan Sports.
